Reminder of Upcoming Data Submission Deadline

The submission deadline for the Inpatient Rehabilitation Facility (IRF) Quality Reporting Program (QRP) is approaching. IRF Patient Assessment Instrument (IRF-PAI) assessment data and data submitted via the Center for Disease Control and Prevention's (CDC's) National Healthcare Safety Network (NHSN) for October December 31 (Q4) of calendar year (CY) 2022 are due with this submission deadline. The annual NHSN measure Influenza Vaccination among Healthcare Personnel is also due with this deadline.

All data must be submitted no later than 11:59 p.m. on May 15, 2023.

It is recommended that the applicable Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) Internet Quality Improvement and Evaluation System (iQIES) reports and NHSN analysis reports are run prior to each quarterly reporting deadline to ensure that all required data were submitted. We encourage you to verify all facility information prior to submission, including CMS Certification Number (CCN) and facility name.

IRF PPS for FY 2024; and Updates to the IRF QRP (CMS-1781-P)

On April 3,2023, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) issued a proposed rule (CMS-1781-P) that provides proposals for the fiscal year (FY) 2024 Inpatient Rehabilitation Facility Quality Reporting Program (IRF QRP). This rule includes two new measure proposals, one measure modification proposal, and three measure removal proposals. The new measure proposals include the Discharge Function Score measure and the COVID-19 Vaccine: Percent of Patients/Residents Who Are Up to Date measure. CMS is also proposing to modify the COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage among Healthcare Personnel (HCP) measure to report the number of HCP who are up to date with recommended COVID-19 vaccinations per the latest Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidance. In addition, CMS is proposing the removal of three measures including the Application of Percent of Long-Term Care Hospital (LTCH) Patients with an Admission and Discharge Functional Assessment and a Care Plan That Addresses Function; the IRF Functional Outcome Measure: Change in Self-Care Score for Medical Rehabilitation Patients; and the IRF Functional Outcome Measure: Change in Mobility Score for Medical Rehabilitation Patients. We are also proposing to begin the public reporting of the Transfer of Health Information to the Patient-Post-Acute Care (PAC) and Transfer of Health Information to the Provider-PAC measures. Finally, we are seeking information on principles for selecting and prioritizing IRF QRP quality measures and concepts and providing an update on p continued efforts to close the health equity gap.
