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### NPPES Data Dissemination Notice May 30, 2007

- Describes the policy by which CMS will make certain NPPES health care provider data publicly available
- Lists the data CMS will be disclosing

## Certain NPPES Data Elements Are Not Being Disclosed

- SSN
- IRS ITIN
- Date of Birth
- State of Birth
- Country of Birth
- Contact Person Information (name, title, telephone, email)
- Information for providers whose NPIs are deactivated

## Availability of Disclosable Data

- A query-only database (NPI Registry)
- Downloadable file
- This information will be available to the public on the Internet in accordance with the e-FOIA amendments to the FOIA.
- There will be no charge to access the NPI Registry or download the files.

## "Custom" Requests for Disclosable Data

- More or less data than what must be disclosed by the Notice
- Different media
- Processed by CMS FOIA Office in accordance with FOIA procedures

# Reminder: The Final Rule's Disclosure Requirements

- Covered providers are required to disclose their NPIs to any entity that requires them for use in standard transactions.
- Covered organization providers that have subparts that have been assigned NPIs must ensure that those <u>subparts</u> disclose their NPIs.
- Other health care providers who are assigned NPIs are expected, but not required, to disclose their NPIs, upon request, to any entity that needs them for use in standard transactions.

## Downloadable File

- <u>http://nppesdata.cms.hhs.gov/CMS\_NPI\_files.html</u>
- The initial file will represent a "snapshot" of the FOIA-disclosable data on a specific date.
- Each month, a replacement file will be posted, and the previous month's file will be removed.

## Downloadable File

- The replacement file is a more recent "snapshot" of the FOIA-dislcosable data.
- Update files are unnecessary.
- Note: CMS may decide to change the frequency or manner of making this information available.

- Read Me Document\*
- Code Value Document\*
- Header File\*
- Data File

## Downloadable File

- File must be downloaded by technical personnel.
- Neither the Enumerator or CMS will assist in downloading the file or manipulating the data.

# NPI Registry

- <u>https://nppes.cms.hhs.gov</u>
- Query-only
- Real time
- Anyone with a computer and Internet may use the NPI Registry
- Users may query by Entity type, then by NPI, provider name, ZIP code or State.
- Query by NPI will search both Entity types and display results if NPI is found in either Entity type.

# **NPI** Registry

- Up to 150 results may be returned (depending on query).
- Users can narrow the results.
- Users select the provider they want from the "results" page.
- "Details" page then display the FOIAdisclosable data for the selected provider.

- NPI Registry Available September 4, 2007
- Downloadable File Available September 12, 2007



CAUTION: SSNs or ITINs in FOIAdisclosable Fields Other Provider Identifiers License Number Credentials • Illogical Fields (e.g., name, address)

### Recommendations for Action by Providers

- Review your NPPES data and make any necessary edits.
- Remove Social Security Numbers (SSNs) if reported in fields other than the designated SSN field!
- Ensure SSNs are not reported in EIN field (organizations only)!
- Never put another provider's SSN in your NPPES record anywhere.
- Clearly report legacy numbers (if you choose to report them).
- Review/make edits at *https://nppes.cms.hhs.gov*

# Reminder: The Final Rule's Update Requirements

- Covered providers must update their NPPES data within 30 days of the change.
- Covered organization providers that have subparts that have been assigned NPIs must ensure that those subparts update their NPPES data within 30 days of the change.
- Other health care providers who have been assigned NPIs are encouraged to do the same.
- Make changes or check your data at <u>https://nppes.cms.hhs.gov/</u>.

## FOIA-disclosable Data

- Some data cannot be updated, changed or deleted (only optional data can be deleted).
- Document to assist providers is downloadable from <u>http://www.cms.hhs.gov/NationalProvIdent</u> <u>Stand/Downloads/NPPES\_FOIA\_Data%2</u> <u>0Elements\_062007.pdf</u>

### "Other Provider Identifiers"

- An optional, but very important, field.
- CMS urges you to consider reporting your legacy identifiers, not only for Medicare but for all plans, in the "Other Provider Identifiers" field
- Critical information for plans in the development of crosswalks to transition to the NPI.
  - This section captures legacy numbers assigned to the provider by health plans.
  - If providing this information, indicate the health plan name along with the identifier assigned by that health plan.
  - Do NOT report SSNs or ITINs in this field!
  - Providers may decide to remove sensitive identifiers if they were reported (e.g., DEA Number)

# Editing NPPES Data

- Use the web-based system
  - Most health care providers can submit updates to their NPPES data electronically via the Web.
