SUBJECT: Hospital Complaint Investigation Webinar: Friday, November 22, 2013

Memorandum Summary

- **Upcoming Webinar:** The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is offering a training webinar on Friday, November 22, 2013 at 1:00 pm EST on “Hospital Complaint Investigation Processes.” The webinar will present selected topics on the complaint investigation process in hospitals and critical access hospitals (CAH).
- **Target Audience:** This webinar is intended for all State Survey Agency (SA) and Regional Office (RO) hospital and CAH surveyors and other interested SA and RO personnel. (Mandatory for hospital and CAH surveyors)

Background:

On Friday, November 22, 2013 at 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm EST, CMS will present a webinar on the hospital complaint investigation process. The webinar will include a brief overview of changes to Chapter 5 of the State Operations Manual (SOM). Further, using a scenario-based approach, it will focus on common errors, omissions, and misconceptions related to the complaint investigation process in hospitals and CAHs.

The webinar will address topics that have proven to be challenging for SAs and ROs, such as the scope of the complaint investigation (specific complaint vs. the whole Condition of Participation), appropriate sample size, inappropriate reference to state licensure standards when evaluating compliance with Medicare standards, how past noncompliance may or may not be relevant in determining current compliance, etc. It will include audience participation through

polling questions and responding to scenario-related situations, as well as question and answer sessions.

We encourage all SA and RO personnel who participate in hospital and CAH complaint investigation survey activities to participate. The intent of the webinar is to clarify and promote a consistent, comprehensive, and thorough investigative process consistent with requirements as detailed in the SOM in Chapter 5, Appendix A for hospitals, and Appendix W for CAHs.
