Memorandum Summary

- QIES Systems Will be unavailable from March 16 through March 21, 2016.
- Submission of Patient/Resident Assessments will not be possible during the downtime Providers were notified in several email messages that the QIES system would be unavailable during the downtime. Providers were advised to plan their business needs around the downtime.

The QIES system is used by providers to submit assessment information such as the Minimum Data Set (MDS) for nursing homes and OASIS for home health agencies. QIES is also used by State Survey Agencies and staff at the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) to produce reports on assessment information and survey status of providers and suppliers.

Providers were notified of the downtime through multiple email messages from the QIES system. Staff from CMS also announced the downtime at provider Open Door Forums. Providers were advised to plan the submission of assessment data around the downtime.
