On August 20, 2019, the Department of Health & Human Services and the Department of the Treasury approved Delaware's State Innovation Waiver under section 1332 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA). Delaware's application sought to waive PPACA's requirement for the single risk pool to implement a state reinsurance program called the Delaware Health Insurance Individual Market Stabilization Reinsurance Program for plan years 2020 through 2024. It is the Department of the Treasury's final administrative determination that Delaware's pass-through funding amount is \$21,675,647 for calendar year 2020.

On August 20, 2019, the Department of Health & Human Services and the Department of the Treasury approved Delaware's State Innovation Waiver under section 1332 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA). Delaware's application sought to waive PPACA's requirement for the single risk pool to implement a state reinsurance program called the Delaware Health Insurance Individual Market Stabilization Reinsurance Program for plan years 2020 through 2024. The pass-through funding associated with this waiver for calendar year 2020 is estimated to be \$21,674,268. This amount will be subject to a final administrative determination by the Department of the Treasury prior to payment.
