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OVERVIEW

The Medicare Parts C and D Oversight and Enforcement Group (MOEG) will host a three-part training series to provide technical assistance on the final audit protocols it will use to conduct the Medicare Part C and Part D Program Audits (CMS-10717) in 2022.

These calls will not include a live Q&A session. MOEG solicited program area specific questions, using a pre-event survey, from organizations to develop content for this training series and has incorporated this feedback into the training material. The pre-event survey closed on July 2, 2021. Registrants will be allowed to submit questions during each session via the Q&A pod; however, CMS will provide direct responses after the conclusion of the user call series.

SESSIONS SUMMARY



Each program area session presentation will provide an overview of the Program Audit Protocols and Program Audit Data Request that are included in CMS-10717. The presenters of each session will review the compliance standards within each program area and explain how the selected requirements are tested in the context of our method of evaluation. This discussion will promote stakeholder understanding of the review process and allow them to identify which internal systems may be impacted.

The second half of each training will be a detailed review of the technical specifications in the record layouts that audited organizations use to collect and submit data for a program audit. This portion of the training will allow stakeholders an opportunity to hear CMS expand on the technical specifications of data points within each record layout and become aware of efforts CMS made to align record layouts across program areas for consistency in data collection.

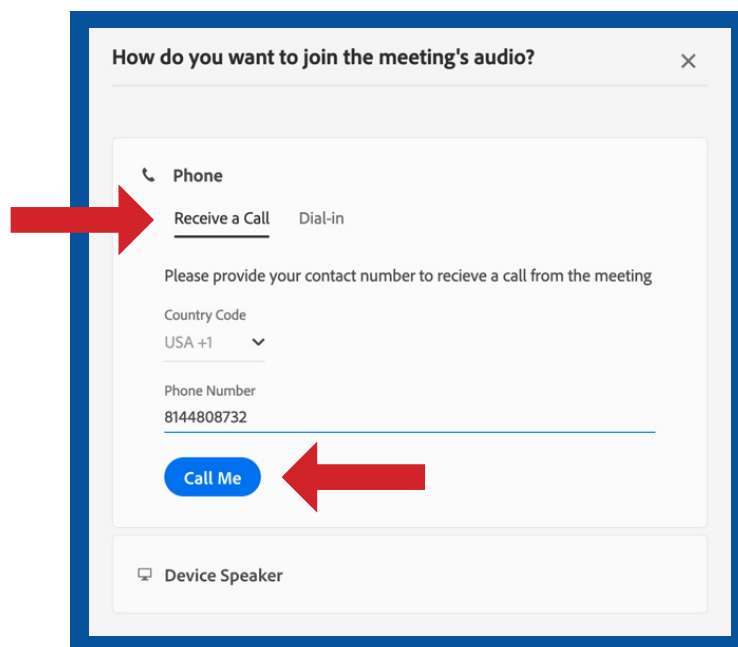
- 3 To connect your audio, follow the prompts that appear once you join the Adobe Connect platform. We recommend selecting the **Phone** option and then the **Receive a Call** option.

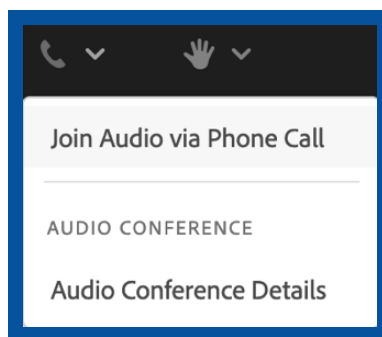

- 4 If you choose the **Receive a Call** option, type in your telephone number (including area code). The country code defaults to the United States.
- 5 Select **Call Me**, and the platform will call your phone directly to connect you to the event.



- 6 If the audio prompts do not appear on your screen when you join, please follow the steps below to connect your audio.

- At the top of your screen, you will see a phone icon. Click the small dropdown arrow next to the phone icon, and select **Join Audio via Phone Call**.



- Once selected, the audio options will appear on your screen. Follow steps 3-5 (above) to connect your audio.



Using the Q&A Pod in Adobe Connect

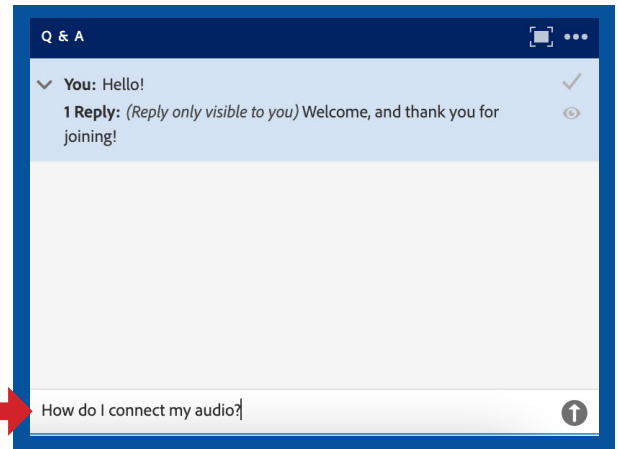
Type your message into the text box, and hit enter on your keyboard or click the arrow to send your message.

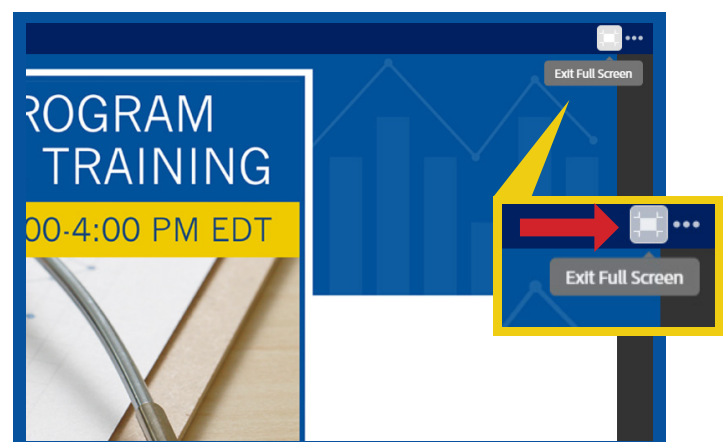
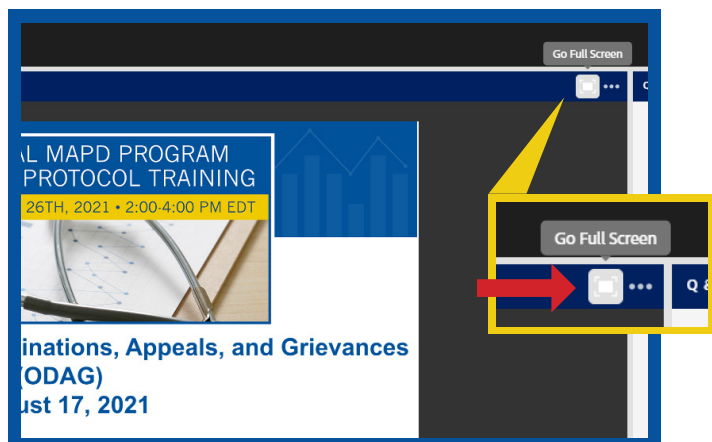
Technical assistance will be provided during the webinar via Q&A. Send a message in the Q&A pod, and a member of the CTEO Team will respond to you privately.
