Notice is hereby given that on August 4, 2017 the agreement between Maximum Home Health Care, Munster, Indiana, and the Secretary of Health and Human Services, as a home health agency in the Medicare program will be terminated.

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services has determined that Maximum Home Health Care is not in compliance with the following Medicare Conditions of Participation for home health agencies.

- 42 CFR §484.10 – Patient’s Rights
- 42 CFR §484.14 – Organization, Services, and Administration
- 42 CFR §484.18 – Acceptance of Patients, Plan of Care, and Medical Supervision
- 42 CFR §484.30 – Skilled Nursing Services
- 42 CFR §484.48 – Clinical Records

The Medicare program will not make payment for home health services furnished to patients whose plan of treatment was established on or after August 4, 2017. For patients whose plan of treatment was established prior to August 4, 2017, payment will be made for up to 30 days of covered services furnished after August 4, 2017.
