Open Payments Program Year 2017



Total Dollar Value of Published Records*

In Program Year 2017, applicable manufacturers and group purchasing organizations (GPOs) reported 11.54 million records totaling \$8.40 billion in payments and ownership/ investment interests to physicians and teaching hospitals.

Payments in the three major reporting categories are:

General Payments: \$2.82 billion Research Payments: \$4.66 billion

Ownership and Investment Interests: \$927 million

Over the course of the Open Payments program CMS has published 53 million records, accounting for \$33.42 billion in payments and ownership and investment interests.

Review and Dispute Summary

Physicians and teaching hospitals are provided an opportunity to review data attributed to them. Through the review and dispute process they may affirm the records are correct and/or dispute any records they believe to be incomplete or inaccurate. Physicians and teaching hospitals work directly with the reporting entity to resolve the dispute; CMS does not mediate disputes.

Physicians and teaching hospitals may review, affirm, or dispute the data attributed to them through the end of the calendar year in which the records are published. Open Payments Program Year 2017 data is still eligible for review through the end of the 2018 calendar year.
