Transmittal R193, dated August 26, 2011, is being rescinded and replaced by Transmittal 200, dated November 16, 2011, to align reporting requirements with those in CR 7604. Specifically, in the exhibit (Monthly Recovery Auditor Appeals and Reopenings Report) (i) Disposition D: Request dismissed by Recovery Auditor has been omitted; (ii) disposition “M” Dismissed per MAC initiative has been revalued as “D” for consistency in reporting, (iii) this issuance also modifies the definition of “Reason for Reversal” code “G”; and (iv) clarifies that codes “A” through “G” are to be used for appeals, while codes “H” through “O” apply to clerical reopenings and (v) “Provider/Suppliers”. In addition, we are correcting the erroneous omission of the revision number, and effective and implementation dates from the manual revisions. The transmittal number, date issued, and all other information will remain the same.
