Dear Commissioner Conway:

On June 23, 2022, the Department of Health and Human Services and the Department of the Treasury approved Colorado's amendment of its State Innovation Waiver under Section 1332 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ACA). Colorado's approved amendment application waives the ACA's requirement for the single risk pool to the extent necessary to implement a state reinsurance program in the individual market called the Colorado Reinsurance Program, and to implement the Colorado Option in the individual and small group markets for plan years 2023 through 2027.

It is the Department of the Treasury's final administrative determination that Colorado's pass-through funding amount for calendar year 2025 is \$339,125,752, which must be used for purposes of implementing Colorado's State Innovation Waiver. This amount reflects changes in Colorado state law or regulation that impact the waiver, such as an adjustment to the state's enhanced cost-sharing reduction subsidy for eligible consumers.
