On August 16, 2022, the Department of Health & Human Services and the Department of the Treasury approved Idaho's State Innovation Waiver under Section 1332 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ACA). Idaho's approved application waives the ACA's requirement for the single risk pool to the extent necessary to implement a state reinsurance program called the Idaho Individual High Risk Reinsurance Pool for plan years 2023 through 2027.

It is the Department of the Treasury's final administrative determination that Idaho's pass-through funding amount for calendar year 2025 is \$148,691,893, which must be used for purposes of implementing Idaho's State Innovation Waiver.
