On December 1, 2022, the Department of Health and Human Services and the Department of the Treasury approved Wisconsin's application for an extension of its State Innovation Waiver under Section 1332 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ACA). Wisconsin's approved extension application waives the ACA's requirement for the single risk pool to the extent necessary to continue to implement a state reinsurance program called the Wisconsin Healthcare Stability Plan for plan years 2024 through 2028.

It is the Department of the Treasury's final administrative determination that Wisconsin's pass-through funding amount for calendar year 2025 is \$223,287,237, which must be used for purposes of implementing Wisconsin's State Innovation Waiver.
