Quick Start Guide for Health Care Providers

## What health care providers should know.

Registration in the Open Payments system is voluntary but is strongly encouraged by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). Your participation in the Open Payments program helps to ensure the integrity and accuracy of any payment data attributed to you before it is published online by CMS.

## Who should register.

You can register for Open Payments if you are a physician or non-physician practitioner who is licensed in a U.S. state. These positions, along with teaching hospitals, are considered "covered recipients" under the Open Payments program.

If you are a U.S.-licensed practitioner who works abroad, you will need to contact the Open Payments Help Desk at 1-855-326-8366 or <u>openpayments@cms.hhs.gov</u>.

## A two-part process.

Registration requires a two-part personal and professional identity check and verification to ensure the security, privacy, and integrity of your data.

Identity Management System (IDM) at

- · Device manufacturers
- · Group purchasing organizations (GPOs)

Gather this information before you start:

- Basic personal information
- Business contact information
- Primary practice business address
- Physician type and taxonomy code
- License number(s) and state(s)
- National Provider Identifier (if you have one)
- Drug Enforcement Administration number (if you have one)

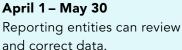
## **Annual Cycle**
