Financial Arrangement List Overview

This subsection gives an overview of the FAL process and the steps involved in the process. This section also gives background on the FAL terminology, partner types, and submission requirements.

Get the Right File

What is the Financial Arrangement List (FAL)?

Pursuant to Article 5 and Article 8 of the BPCI Advanced Participation Agreement, Participants may elect to enter into Financial Arrangements. If the Participant elects to enter into Financial Arrangements, then the Participant is required to submit and maintain a FAL in accordance with Article 8.5 of the Participation Agreement.

Why does CMS collect the FAL?

CMS uses the FAL to record Participants' NPRA Sharing Partners, NPRA Sharing Group Practice Practitioners, and/or BPCI Advanced Entities that are party to a Financial Arrangement. An individual or entity must be identified on the Financial Arrangement List (FAL) in order to partake in Internal Cost Savings, NPRA Shared Payments, and Shared Repayment Amounts.

CMS also uses the FAL to determine the Medicare enrollment status of all organizations/providers that are listed on the FAL as NPRA Sharing Partners, or NPRA Sharing Group Practice Practitioners.

The FAL is a voluntary deliverable, however, all Participants that elect to engage in Financial Arrangements are required to submit a FAL with all NPRA Sharing Partners, NPRA Sharing Group Practice Practitioners, and/or BPCI Advanced Entities. The FAL is collected bi-annually for the first and third quarter of each calendar year.





The Financial Arrangement "Partner" Types

"NPRA Sharing Partner" is a Participating Practitioner, a PGP, an ACH, an ACO, or a PAC Provider that is:

(1) participating in BPCI Advanced Activities;

(2) identified as an NPRA Sharing Partner on the Financial Arrangement List; and

(3) has entered into a written NPRA Sharing Arrangement.

"NPRA Sharing Group Practice Practitioner" is a Medicare-enrolled physician or non-physician practitioner who is:

- (1) identified by an individual NPI;
- (2) has reassigned his or her right to receive Medicare payment to the TIN of a PGP NPRA Sharing Partner;
- (3) is participating in BPCI Advanced Activities;
- (4) is identified as an NPRA Sharing Group Practice Practitioner on the Financial Arrangement List; and
- (5) has entered into a Partner Distribution Arrangement.

"BPCI Advanced Entity" is an entity that administers the Participant's Financial Arrangements pursuant to a BPCI Advanced Entity Agreement





FAL and QPP List Intersection

BPCI Advanced QPP List:

The quarterly submission of a BPCI Advanced QPP List is a participation requirement per Article 3.1, and Article 6 of the BPCI Advanced Participation Agreement. The BPCI Advanced QPP List serves 2 purposes:

- 1. Identification of Participating Practitioners implementing the Model, and
- 2. Identification of eligible clinicians associated with an Alternative Payment Model (APM) Entity that will be included in the quarterly report to the CMS Quality Payment Program for Qualifying APM Participant (QP) determinations.

Financial Arrangement Eligibility Requirements (Article 8.2):

The NPRA Sharing Partner or NPRA Sharing Group Practice Practitioner, as applicable, must:

- 1. be identified on the Financial Arrangement List during the applicable Performance Period;
- 2. be engaged in BPCI Advanced Activities during the applicable Performance Period;

If a clinician is "engaged in BPCI Advanced Activities", then they are considered a "Participating Practitioner" implementing the Model and the individual must be listed in the BPCI Advanced QPP List for the period covered by the FAL.

Any individual listed in the FAL must appear in the QPP List, but not every individual listed in the QPP List needs to be listed in the FAL. There is no obligation for Participants in the Model to share savings with clinicians and/or other organizations. But if they do, then Participants must comply with the requirements of the Participation Agreement and the Fraud and Abuse Waivers.





FAL Process Overview

Proposed Financial Arrangement List (PFAL)

The PFAL is the first iteration of the FAL. Participants that elect to enter Financial Arrangements must submit a PFAL that lists each NPRA Sharing Partner, NPRA Sharing Group Practice Practitioner, and/or BPCI Advanced Entity that Participant expects to have Financial Arrangements with for the given period. Along with the PFAL, the Participant must submit a Model Deliverable Certification Form stating that such list is a true, accurate, and complete list, signed by an executive of the Participant.

PFAL Vetting

CMS will conduct a Center for Program Integrity (CPI) screening of all organizations and individuals listed on the PFAL to determine the Medicare enrollment status of all NPRA Sharing Partners and NPRA Sharing Group Practice Practitioners. Non-Medicare providers are screened manually by CMS for any sanctions, settlements, and justifications.

FAiL Report

CMS will only distribute FAiL Reports to Participants who listed an organization or individual in the PFAL that failed the CPI screening. Participants will have the opportunity to review the FAiL report and provide corrections for organizations/individuals that failed the CPI screening.

Tentative Financial Arrangement List (TFAL)

CMS will submit to the Participant in writing a list of individuals and entities that CMS has approved to be NPRA Sharing Partners, NPRA Sharing Group Practice Practitioners, and BPCI Advanced Entities on a TFAL.

The Participant shall review the TFAL and must remove from it any NPRA Sharing Partner with which the Participant does not have a fully executed NPRA Sharing Arrangement, any NPRA Sharing Group Practice Practitioner that does not have a fully executed Partner Distribution Arrangement, and any BPCI Advanced Entity that does not have a fully executed Partner Distribution Arrangement, and any BPCI Advanced Entity Agreement.



The Participant will not be able to add any individuals or entities to their FAL after the submission of the PFAL for the given quarter.





FAL Process Overview

Initial Financial Arrangement List/Updated Financial Arrangement List (IFAL/UFAL)

The Participant shall submit to CMS the TFAL that the Participant has certified is a true, accurate, and complete list, identifying all the Participant's NPRA Sharing Partners, NPRA Sharing Group Practice Practitioners, and BPCI Advanced Entities who are approved by CMS to participate in BPCI Advanced and that have a fully executed NPRA Sharing Arrangement, Partner Distribution Arrangement, or BPCI Advanced Entity Agreement.

After the Participant submits the TFAL document back to CMS via the Participant Portal, it will automatically become the IFAL/UFAL. The IFAL is the first iteration of a final FAL, and any subsequent final FALs will be UFALs. A Model Deliverable Certification Form should also be submitted in the supporting documentation section of the IFAL/UFAL. This Financial Arrangement List (IFAL/UFAL) will reflect the current list of NPRA Sharing Partners, NPRA Sharing Group Practice Practitioners, and BPCI Advanced Entities effective as of the start of a given semi-annual period.





The Financial Arrangement List process is a multi-step process, which involves the submission of multiple iterations of the FAL throughout the given reporting period.



- **1**. The PFAL is due when specified by CMS.
 - 30 days before the start of the quarter (i.e., Q3 202X) or Two weeks prior to the start of the Model Year.
 - It must be accompanied by a Model Deliverable Certification Form.

2. The PFAL information is vetted by CMS.

 This process takes 3 - 4 weeks. The organizations and individuals submitted in the PFAL are compared to the information in PECOS.

3. The FAiL Report is created and released.

- The Participants have 10 business days to review and submit corrections.
- 4. The TFALs are created based on the information submitted in the PFAL and any corrections to the FAiL.
 - The TFALs are uploaded to the Participant Portal.
- 5. The Participants review & accept the TFAL.
 - The Participants have 10 business days to review the TFAL.
 - Participants should remove from it any organizations, individuals, or entities that they do not have a Financial Arrangement with, and upload the final FAL.
 - Upon upload, it will automatically become the IFAL/UFAL.





Obtaining the Template

The PFAL template should be downloaded from the Participant Portal. First log on to the Participant Portal, then select Deliverables from the menu on the left side of the screen.

Review Instructions and Populate the PFAL

Once you have downloaded the template, please review the Instructions tabs in the PFAL template and populate all required fields in the appropriate tabs (i.e., Organizations, Individuals, BPCI Advanced Entity).

Review Instructions and Revise the FAiL Report

After the information from your submitted PFAL has been reviewed, any errors will be identified and placed in a FAiL Report. A FAiL Report will be uploaded in the Participant Portal for all BPIDs that listed an organization or individual that failed CPI vetting. Each organization/individual will have a status of either Pass, Pass with Corrections, or Fail. If the status is Pass with Corrections, please review the correction(s) and make sure that the information is accurate. If the status is FAiL, please make corrections in the appropriate area and provide any applicable supporting documents (i.e., documents the support the information in question).

Review Instructions and Certify the TFAL

After the FAiL Report revisions have been received, Participants will receive a TFAL containing individuals and entities that CMS has approved to be NPRA Sharing Partners, NPRA Sharing Group Practice Practitioners, or BPCI Advanced Entitles. Participants shall review the TFAL and must remove any organizations or individuals that the Participant does not have an executed Sharing Agreement with. Participants shall submit to CMS the FAL and a Certification Form. Once the TFAL has been submitted, the TFAL automatically becomes the IFAL/UFAL, which is the final iteration of the FAL.





PFAL Instructions Tab

The PFAL instructions tab is broken into four sections: Overview, instructions for the Organizations worksheet, instructions for the Individuals worksheet, and instructions for the BPCI Advanced Entities worksheet. It is recommended that the instructions tab be read in its entirety before filling out the template.

Overview: The overview section depicts overarching themes relevant to the PFAL. Definitions of entities eligible for financial arrangements i.e., NPRA Sharing Partner (SP), NPRA Sharing Group Practice Practitioner (SGPP), and BPCI Advanced Entity are provided in accordance with the worksheet they must be listed on.

Organizations Worksheet Instructions: The "Organizations" worksheet should only be used to list Medicare providers: Acute Care Hospitals (ACHs), Accountable Care Organizations (ACOs), Home Health Agencies (HHAs), Inpatient Rehabilitation Facilities (IRFs), Long Term Care Hospitals (LTCHs), Physician Group Practices (PGPs), and/or Skilled Nursing Facilities (SNFs). The instructions provide an explanation of each column, the information required in that column, and key tips for entering the information accurately.

Individuals Worksheet Instructions: The "Individuals" worksheet should be used to list physicians and/or non-physician providers. The instructions provide an explanation of each column, the information required in that column, and key tips for entering the information accurately.

BPCI Advanced Entity Instructions: The BPCI Advanced Entity worksheet should only be used to list organizations that fall under the definition of BPCI Advanced Entity in the Participation Agreement. The instructions provide an explanation of each column, the information required in that column, and key tips for entering the information accurately.





PFAL Organizations Tab

The Organizations tab is comprised of 11 columns to be populated by the Participant. The Organizations tab is to be used to record all ACHs, ACOs, HHAs, IRFs, LTCHs, PGPs, and/or SNFs that the Participant may elect to have financial arrangements with.

PFAL Organizations Tab Instructions

Participant BPID (column A) – Enter the BPCI Advanced BPID of the Participant that is sharing NPRA with the listed organization (XXXX-YYYY or AXXX-YYYY, where YYYY is either 0000 or 0001). Do not enter a Downstream Episode Initiator BPID (the last digit will be 2 or higher).

TIN (column B) – Enter the Federal Tax Identification Number (TIN) for each organization that is an NPRA Sharing Partner. The TIN should be entered as nine digits (without dashes). Please verify the TIN against available IRS documentation, and double check to make sure that there are no digits missing (specifically leading zeros) or transposed.

Organizational NPI (column C) – Enter the National Provider Identifier (NPI) for the listed organization. The NPI should have 10 digits and usually starts with either a 1 or a 2. Please ensure that the Organizational NPI matches the information in PECOS and in the Participant Portal. Please review the NPI to ensure that it has 10 digits, no dashes, and verify that no digits have been transposed.

CCN (column D) – Enter the CMS Certification Number for the listed Organization. The CCN is a six-digit number that is assigned to Medicare institutional providers. Please verify the CCN to ensure that it matches the information in PECOS. Please double check the CCN against available documentation. Ensure that the CCN has six digits, no dashes, and verify that numbers have not been transposed. If the organization does not have a CCN, leave this field blank.

ACO ID (column E) - Enter the ACO Identifier (assigned by Medicare to ACOs) for the listed organization, if the organization is an ACO. If the organization does not have an ACO ID, leave this field blank.

Legal Business Name (column F) – Enter the legal business name for each organization that is an NPRA Sharing Partner. Please double check the legal business name against PECOS, and if the organization is an Episode Initiator, the Participant Portal. Please do not use the "Doing Business As (DBA)" name in this field. Except for legal designations (i.e., Inc., LLC, PLLC), please do not use abbreviations.





PFAL Organizations Tab Instructions

Organization Type (column G) – Select the Organization Type from the drop-down menu (The Organization must be an ACH, ACO, HHA, IRF, LTCH, PGP, or SNF). If the organization is not a Medicare provider, it should not be listed in the Organizations sheet.

Effective Start Date (column H) – Enter the effective date (start day) the organization became or will become an NPRA Sharing Partner. The date must be in the format MM/DD.YYYY. The date must be between 10/01/2018 and the end of the current quarter.

Effective End Date (column I) – Enter effective date (last day) the organization will cease being an NPRA Sharing Partner. The date must be in the format MM/DD/YYYY. The end date must be after 10/01/2018. If the financial arrangement is ongoing (not terminating), the effective end date should be left blank.

Adding New Organization (column J) – Identify any new organization that will begin as an NPRA Sharing Partner for the reporting quarter. If the organization was listed on a previous FAL, then leave this field blank. If the organization is being added to the FAL, then identify the organization with a "yes" in this column.

Removing Organizations (column K) – Identify any organizations that will cease being an NPRA Sharing Partner for the reporting quarter or previous one. If the organization is still an NPRA Sharing Partner on a previous FAL, then leave this column blank. If the organization is being removed from the FAL, then identify the organization with a "Yes" in this column.





PFAL Individuals Tab

The "Individuals" tab is comprised of 10 columns to be populated by the Participant. The "Individuals" tab should be used to list all physicians and/or non-physician providers that have elected to enter into a financial arrangement with the Participant.

PFAL Individuals Tab Instructions

Participant BPID (column A) – Enter the BPCI Advanced BPID of the Participant that is sharing NPRA with the listed organization (XXXX-YYYY or AXXX-YYYY, where YYYY is either 0000 or 0001). Do not enter a Downstream Episode Initiator BPID (the last digit will be 2 or higher).

Individual NPI (column B) – Enter the National Provider Identifier (NPI) for the Individual that is an NPRA Sharing Partner (SP) or an NPRA Sharing Group Practice Practitioner (SGPP). Ensure that the individual NPI matches the information in PECOS. Do not list an organization's NPI. The NPI must be that of the individual provider. Please double check the individual NPI against available documentation. Please review the NPI to ensure that it has 10 digits, no dashes, and verify that no digits have been transposed.

Last Name (column C) – Enter the last name for the Individual that is an NPRA Sharing Partner (SP) or an NPRA Sharing Group Practice Practitioner (SGPP). Please double check the spelling of the individual's last name. The last name must match the last name found in PECOS. Do not add any professional titles or certifications (i.e., MD, DO, PA, PhD) to the last name field.

First Name (column D) – Enter the first name of the Individual that is an NPRA Sharing Partner (SP) or an NPRA Sharing Group Practice Practitioner (SGPP). Please double check the spelling of the individual's first name. The first name must match the first name found in PECOS. Please do not use abbreviated first names, nick names, or alias first names. Please do not add middle initials. Do not add any professional titles or certifications (i.e., MD, DO, PA, PhD) to the last name field.

Effective Start Date (column E) – Enter the effective start date (first day) in which the Individual will start as an NPRA Sharing Partner (SP) or as NPRA Sharing Group Practice Practitioner (SGPP). The start date must be between 10/01/2018 and the end of the current quarter. Enter the date in the MM/DD/YYYY format.

Effective End Date (column F) – List the effective end date (last day) in which the Individual will cease participating as an NPRA Sharing Partner (SP) or as NPRA Sharing Group Practice Practitioner (SGPP). The end date must be after 10/01/2018. Enter the date in the MM/DD/YYYY format. If the financial arrangement is ongoing (not terminating), the effective end date should be left blank.





PFAL Individuals Tab Instructions

NPRA Sharing Partner Type (column G) – From the drop-down menu, select the correct designation for the Individual - NPRA Sharing Partner (SP) or NPRA Sharing Group Practice Practitioner (SGPP). Before making your selection, please review the following definitions.

- NPRA Sharing Partner (SP) a Participating Practitioner, a PGP, an ACH, an ACO, or a PAC Provider that is: (1) participating in BPCI Advanced Activities;
 (2) identified as an NPRA Sharing Partner on the Financial Arrangement List; and (3) has entered into a written NPRA Sharing Arrangement.
- NPRA Sharing Group Practice Practitioner (SGPP) a Medicare-enrolled physician or non-physician practitioner who is: (1) identified by an individual NPI; (2) has reassigned his or her right to receive Medicare payment to the TIN of a PGP NPRA Sharing Partner; (3) is participating in BPCI Advanced Activities; (4) is identified as an NPRA Sharing Group Practice Practitioner on the Financial Arrangement List; and (5) has entered into a Partner Distribution Arrangement.

If "NPRA Sharing Group Practice Practitioner (SGPP)" is selected, then a PGP TIN must be entered in column H. That PGP (which is an "NPRA Sharing Partner [SP]") must be listed in the Organizations worksheet.

NPRA Sharing Partner's Tax Identification Number (TIN) (column H) – For those Individuals who were identified as "NPRA Sharing Group Practice Practitioners (SGPPs)" in column F, you must list the TIN of the PGP that will be making payments to the individual. If the payments will be made directly by the Participant/BPCI Advanced Entity to the Individual (which makes them a "NPRA Sharing Partner" (SP), then leave blank. If payments will be made by the Participant/BPCI Advanced Entity to the PGP, and then the PGP to the Individual (which makes them a "NPRA Sharing Group Practitioner (SGPP)," then: 1) Enter the PGP TIN, a nine-digit number assigned to a business entity, 2) Double-check the TIN against available documentation, 3) Ensure the TIN has nine digits, no dashes, and verify that numbers have not been transposed, and 4) If the TIN begins with a zero, double check that no leading digits were removed from the TIN upon entering the data into the data cell.





PFAL Individuals Tab Instructions

Adding New Individuals (column I) – Identify any new individuals that will begin as an NPRA Sharing Partner. If the individual was listed on a previous FAL, then leave this field blank. If the individual is being added to the FAL, then identify the organization with a "yes" in this column.

Removing Individuals (column J) – Identify any individuals that will cease being an NPRA Sharing Partner. If the individual is still an NPRA Sharing Partner on a previous FAL, then leave this column blank. If the organization is being removed from the FAL, then identify the organization with a "Yes" in this column.





PFAL BPCI Advanced Entity Tab

The BPCI Advanced Entity tab is comprised of 7 columns to be filled out by the Participant. The BPCI Advanced Entity tab should only be used to list organizations that fall under the BPCI Advanced Entity category as defined in the Participation Agreement.

"BPCI Advanced Entity" means an entity other than the Participant that administers the Participant's Financial Arrangements pursuant to a BPCI Advanced Entity Agreement. The entity cannot be a Medicare provider or supplier.
