



Physician Fact Sheet

CMS is testing a different approach to value-based care. Bundled Payments for Care Improvement Advanced (BPCI Advanced) Model does this by moving away from individual Fee-For-Service (FFS) payments toward a coordinated approach to the beneficiary's needs.

Who can Participate?

There is a Request for Applications (RFA) for Medicare-enrolled providers and suppliers and Medicare Accountable Care Organizations (ACOs) to start participation in the Model on January 1, 2024 (Model Year 7). The kind of organization you are will determine your options.

What is the Model?

BPCI Advanced is a voluntary bundled payment model that ties both physician and hospital payments to the quality and cost of services provided under a clinical episode "bundle" for a period of 90 days. A Hospital, Physician Group Practice, Medicare Accountable Care Organization, or Convener can apply to take responsibility for coordinating high quality, efficient healthcare. If things go well, Participants may receive additional payments from CMS and if not, Participants will owe CMS money.

- BPCI Advanced aims to support healthcare providers who invest in practice innovation and care redesign, striving to:

 - Improve outcomes
 - Decrease costs
- The Model affords flexibilities in care delivery
- It is an Advanced Alternative Payment Model under the Quality Payment Program
