

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services Office of Minority Health (CMS OMH) is one of eight offices of minority health within the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. CMS OMH works with local and federal partners to eliminate health disparities while improving the health of all minority populations.

**Priority 4:** Optimize Medical and Communication Technology for Rural, Tribal, and Geographically Isolated Communities








### **NOSORH Presentation**



# NOSORH grows connections, tools, and education to support and build vital healthy rural communities.

NOSORH was established in 1995 to assist State Offices of Rural Health (SORH) in their efforts to improve access to, and the quality of, health care for nearly 61 million rural Americans. NOSORH enhances the capacity of SORH to do this by supporting the development of state and community rural health leaders; creating and facilitating state, regional, and national partnerships that foster information sharing and spur rural health-related programs/activities; and enhancing access to quality healthcare services in rural communities.





Since 2011, NOSORH has celebrated the "Power of Rural" on National Rural Health Day, the third Thursday of November. This day honors the dedication of rural healthcare providers, communities, State Offices of Rural Health, and stakeholders in addressing rural America's healthcare needs.














HOW TO USE C2C RESOURCES & PARTNER WITH C2C


## Taos Pueblo Health & Community Services


