LEGAL NOTICE OF TERMINATION FROM MEDICARE PROGRAM

Effective on September 22, 2024, the Secretary of the Department of Health & Human Services will terminate its Medicare Provider Agreement with Prospect Home Healthcare, Inc. at new location (15643 Sherman Way, Suite #200A, Van Nuys, California 91406) or any other locations. This action is being taken because the home health agency has not removed the four immediate jeopardies (IJs) found on the Medicare complaint validation survey conducted on August 20-23, 2024, and noncompliance with requirements for participation in the Medicare and Medicaid programs as established by the Social Security Act (Section 1861) and its underlying regulations.

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services has determined that Prospect Home Healthcare, Inc. was not in compliance with four unabated IJs (specifically 42 C.F.R. §§ 484.55(d)(3), 484.105(a), 484.110(a)(1), and 484.110(d)) and the following four (4) Medicare Conditions of Participation for Home Health services under 42 Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.) Part 484:

42 C.F.R. § 484.50 Patient Rights
42 C.F.R. § 484.55 Comprehensive Assessment of Patients
42 C.F.R. § 484.105 Organization and Administration of Services
42 C.F.R. § 484.110 Clinical Records

Medicare and Medicaid programs will not make payments for services furnished to patients who were admitted on or after September 22, 2024. For patients admitted prior to September 22, 2024, payment may be available for up to thirty (30) calendar days after the effective date of termination.
