LEGAL NOTICE OF TERMINATION FROM MEDICARE PROGRAM

Effective on November 20, 2024, the Secretary of the Department of Health & Human Services will terminate its Medicare Provider Agreement with American Veterans Hospice at 2750 N Bellflower Blvd. Suite 107, Long Beach, CA 90815. A Medicare complaint validation survey conducted October 10, 2024, found American Veterans Hospice was not in compliance with requirements for participation in the Medicare and Medicaid programs as established by the Social Security Act (Section 1861) and its underlying regulations.

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services has determined that American Veterans Hospice was not in compliance with the following Medicare Conditions of Participation for Hospice Agencies under 42 Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.) Part 418:

42 C.F.R. § 418.54 Initial and Comprehensive assessment of the patient 42 C.F.R. § 418.114 PERSONNEL QUALIFICATION

Medicare and Medicaid programs will not make payments for services furnished to patients who were admitted on or after November 20, 2024. For patients admitted prior to November 20, 2024, payment may be available for up to thirty (30) calendar days after the effective date of termination.
