GENERAL COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

March 4-6, 2025 **Behavioral Health & Substance Use Disorder Services**

This course will address fraud detection in high-risk behavioral health and SUD service providers.

March 18-20, 2025 **Audit and Investigative Skills**

This course provides tailored training for both new and experienced investigators, focusing on Medicaid provider audits.

April 1-3, 2025 **Program Integrity Directors Symposium**

This interactive symposium is designed for new and returning Medicaid PI directors and CMS to collaboratively discuss emerging Medicaid program integrity trends, issues, and educational needs. The symposium aims to ensure comprehensive training, education, and technical assistance that addresses the evolving challenges and best practices in Medicaid program integrity.

April 22-24, 2025 **Provider Enrollment and Terminations**

This course will address challenges related to the Medicaid provider enrollment processes.

May 13-15, 2025 **Data Analytics and Artificial Intelligence for Fraud Detection**

This course will introduce advanced tools and methodologies for using data analytics and AI to detect fraud in Medicaid.

June 23-27, 2025 **Certified Coder Outpatient Boot Camp**

This course will cover the fundamentals of CPT, ICD-10-CM, and HCPCS Level II coding for professional services and hospital outpatient services. This course is designed to assist in preparation for AAPC's Certified Professional Coder certification (CPC) and provide the framework for applying coding principles in a real-world environment.

GENERAL COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

July 29-31, 2025 **Interactions Between Medicaid Fraud Control Units and Program Integrity Units Symposium**

This symposium offers state Medicaid program integrity directors, or their designee, and Medicaid Fraud Control Unit (MFCU) directors, or their designee, an opportunity to exchange ideas on building and maintaining effective relationships between PI units and MFCUs to combat fraud, waste, and abuse in Medicaid.

August 11-15, 2025 **Billing and Claims Management Boot Camp**

Designed for Medicaid program integrity staff, this course provides an in-depth exploration of reimbursement methodologies, including diagnosis-related groups, condition and revenue codes, value codes, NCCI edits, and the relationship between charges and payments—equipping nurse reviewers, investigators, and auditors with essential skills for effective medical record analysis.

September 23-25, 2025 **Medicaid Managed Care Symposium**

This course will share invaluable perspectives, insights, and expertise in navigating the dynamic landscape of Medicaid Managed Care.

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
