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The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is providing notice that on January 17, 2025, the Greenville Family Medical Centerlocated at 1467 HWY 1 S, Greenville, MS 38701, will have their CLIA certificate limited for the analyte of Sodium due to their failure to meet CLIA requirements.

The facility has been notified that the CLIA certificate was limited on January 2, 2025. CMS is committed to patient safety and quality of care. When the certificate is limited, specifies the specialties or subspecialties of tests that the laboratory is no longer authorized to perform, and that are no longer covered under Medicare.
