The FISS Online Parm File (OPRM) contains members that control HIGLAS processing. Currently, FISS does not restrict access to the HIGLAS parms which allows any FISS user allowed to update the Online Parm File to update the HIGLAS parms. This User CR will allow Medicare Administrative Contractors (MACs) to restrict update access to the HIGLAS, FISS Core and FISS Financial parms to the appropriate resources.

B. Policy: This CR does not implement new policy. This is a system enhancement to allow MACs to enforce existing policy.
