SUBJECT: Send Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) Information from Provider Enrollment Chain and Ownership System (PECOS) to Multi-Carrier System (MCS) Phase 2

I. SUMMARY OF CHANGES: The purpose of this CR is to implement Phase 2 of a two phased approach intended to reduce the 2-day cycle for Multi-Carrier System (MCS) claims processing when data is received from Provider Enrollment, Chain & Ownership System (PECOS) and the National Provider Identifier (NPI) appears on the Master Provider File. To that end, during Phase 2, Provider Enrollment Chain & Ownership System (PECOS) will begin sending Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) data to Multi-Carrier System (MCS) in the existing extract.

- The Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) Tab and corresponding user roles will be added to PECOS Administrative Interface.
- The EFT data for each Medicare ID will be displayed as read-only on the MCS Tab in PECOS.
- The Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) Child Record will be added to the existing MCS Extract.
- PECOS will begin transferring the new MCS EFT Child Record to MCS.
- PECOS will begin sending the A/R 60 in the MCS extract for transmission to MCS once EFT data are added to an enrollment in PECOS.

I. GENERAL INFORMATION

A. Background: This CR will build upon previous changes implemented to update the Provider Enrollment, Chain & Ownership System (PECOS) to the Multi-Carrier System (MCS) Extract.

PECOS will be taking a two phased approach to implementing solutions intended to reduce the 2-day cycle for MCS claims processing when data is received from PECOS and the National Provider Identifier (NPI) appears on the Master Provider File. Based upon analysis performed, this 2-day cycle may be reduced by sending Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) information and related Action Reason (AR) Codes collected in PECOS to MCS via the existing daily extract; thus, eliminating the time and duplicative effort for Medicare Administrative Contractors (MACs) to manually enter the same EFT information into the MCS.

During phase 1, PECOS will receive updates to the following areas.

PECOS Administrative Interface

- Application Data Report (ADR)
- Reconciliation section (RECON)
- Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) Section within the enrollment

Extracts/Database Changes

- Develop process to load EFT inbound files
- Database table updates

Phase 1 changes, scheduled for the January 2021 Release, to PECOS will serve as preparation to start sending EFT Information to the MCS in Phase 2.

This CR is for Phase 2 where PECOS will begin sending Electronic Transfer Funds data to MCS.
