I. GENERAL INFORMATION

A. Background: The purpose of this CR is to update the MCS to display pre-care and post-care global day fields on the MCSDT.

The Medicare Administrative Contractors (MACs) assign a specific number of global days to a procedure code using the MCS Procedure Maintenance screen, accessed through the use of the mnemonic P2. The Pre-Care field defines the number of allowed pre-care service days for the procedure code and the Post-Care field defines the number of allowed post-care service days. Currently this information is displayed on the Full Procedure Code Inquiry screen accessed through the use of the mnemonic FP and displayed in the fields titled PRE and POST. This information does not display for users of the MCSDT. This shall be an enhancement to display the global day, PRE and POST fields on the Procedure Code Inquiry window in MCSDT.
