A. Background: The purpose of this Change Request (CR) is to replace the retired Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) codes 99354-99355 with the current CPT code 99417 for CRs 11914 and 11915.

B. Policy: Section 1115A of the Social Security Act (added by section 3021 of the Affordable Care Act) (42 U.S.C. 1315a) authorizes the CMS Innovation Center to test innovative payment and service delivery models that have the potential to lower Medicare, Medicaid, and Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) spending while maintaining or improving the quality of beneficiaries' care.
