

Medicare and Medicaid Notice to the Public

Notice is hereby given that on April 16, 2025, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) will terminate the agreement between the Secretary of Health and Human Services and Spring Branch Transitional Care, Houston, Texas as a skilled nursing facility in the Medicare program. In addition, as authorized by the Texas State Medicaid Agency, notice is given that the provider's agreement as a nursing facility in the Medicaid program will also be terminated effective April 16, 2025.

CMS has determined that Spring Branch Transitional Care has failed to attain substantial compliance with the following Medicare and Medicaid participation requirements:

483.12(a)(1) -- Free from Abuse and Neglect

The Medicare program will not make payment for skilled nursing facility services furnished to residents admitted to the facility on or after January 4, 2025. For Medicare residents admitted prior to January 4, 2025, payment may continue for up to 30 days of services on or after April 16, 2025, the date of termination.

In addition, Medicaid Federal Financial Participation will not be available to the State for any Medicaid residents admitted to the facility on or after January 4, 2025. For Medicaid residents admitted prior to January 4, 2025, Federal Financial Participation may continue to be made to the State for up to 30 days of covered services to eligible residents furnished on or after April 15, 2025, the date of termination.
