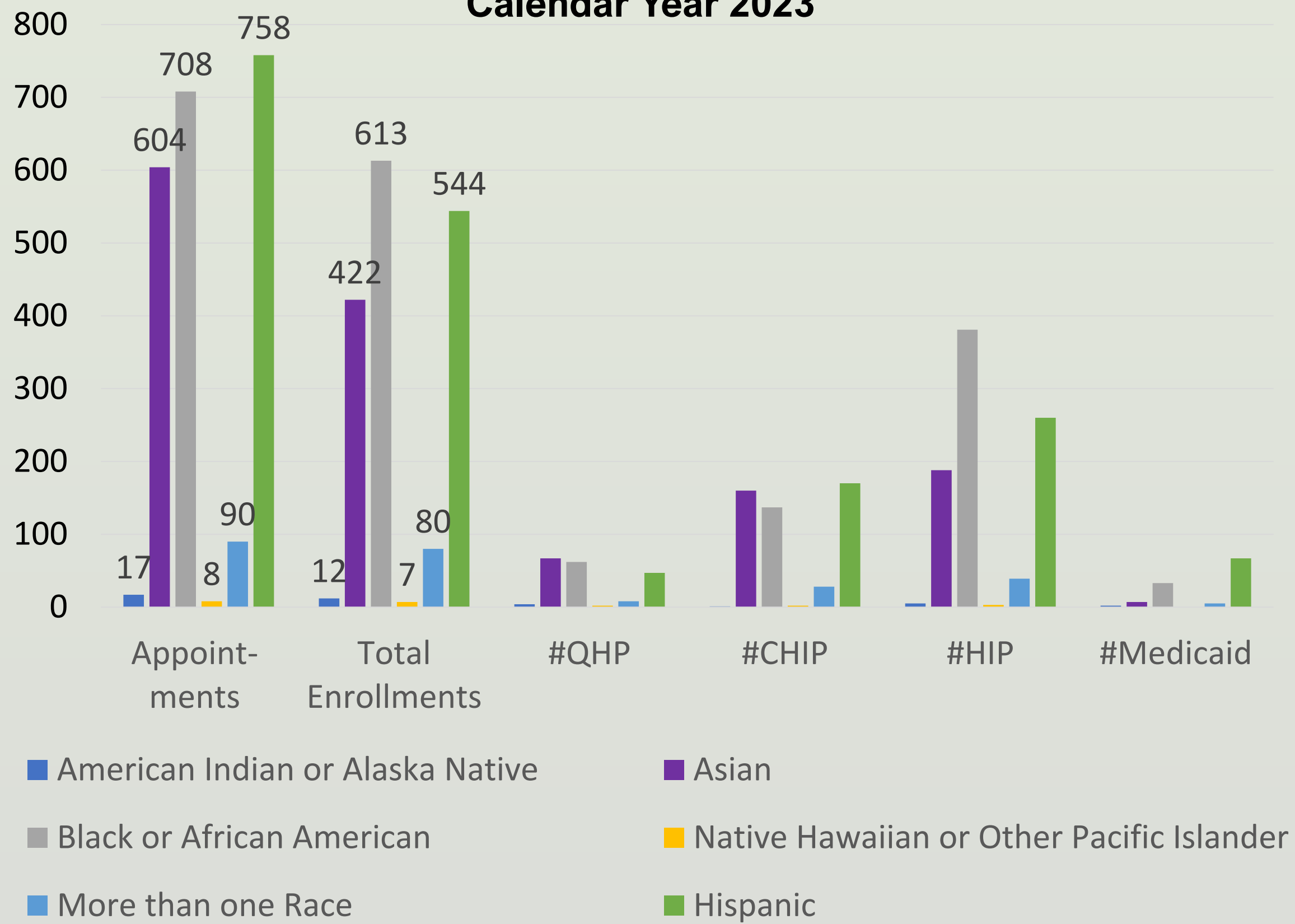


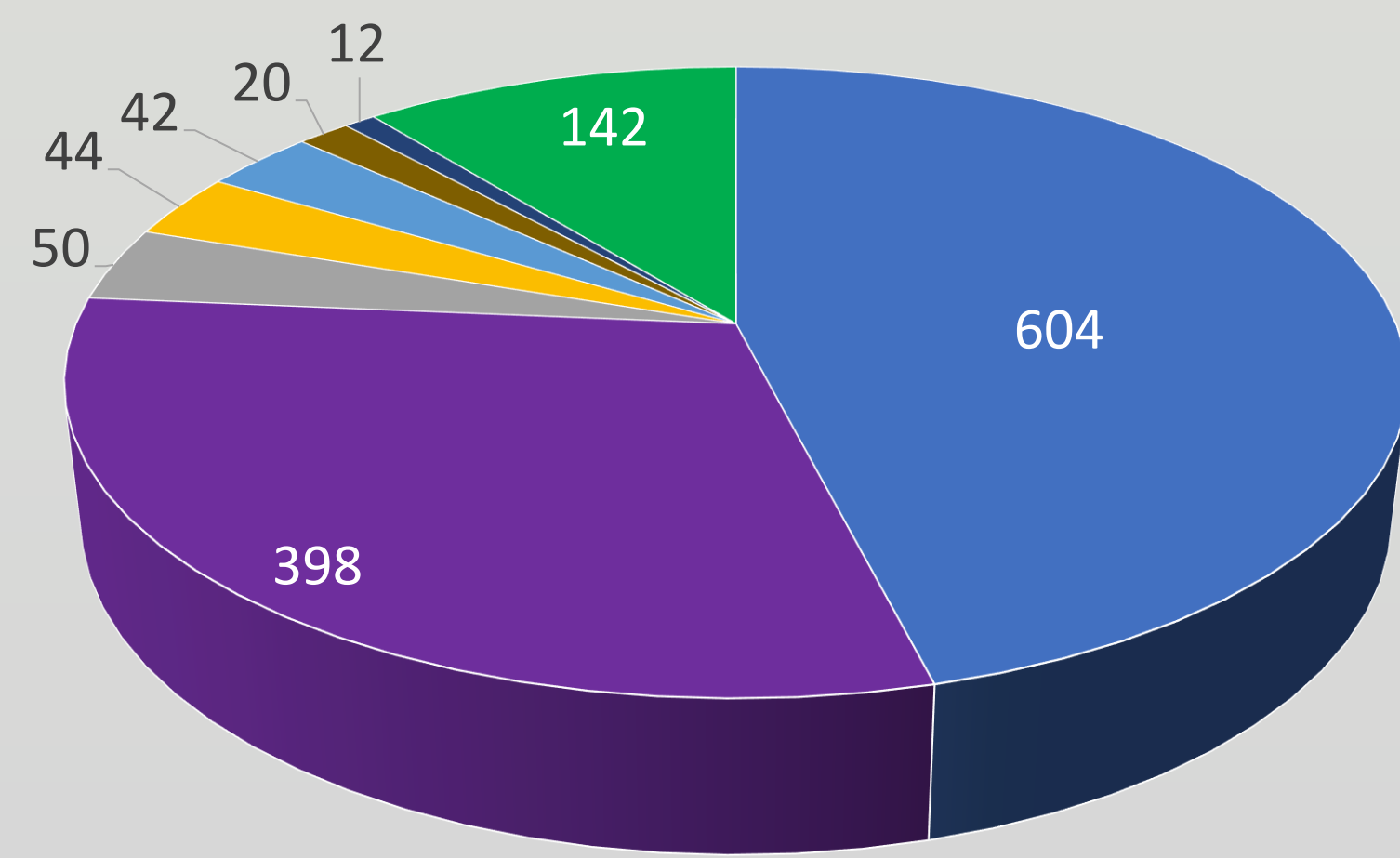

Need

ASPIN Navigators, in recognizing the high rates of uninsured in these communities have partnered with organizations like the Mexican Consulate, Haitian Association of Indiana, Immigrant Welcome Center, Congolese Associations, Exodus Center, and the Global Welcome Center to provide champions in their community's churches, grocery stores, health fairs and enrollments events.

ASPIN has ongoing relationships with many Hispanic ministry groups which were the sites for enrollment events and referrals using in-person and web-based translators. ASPIN was able to assist other limited English-speaking groups such as Arabic, Amharic, Burmese, Cantonese, Chinese, Creole, Eritrea, Farsi, German, Haitian Creole, Hakha Chin, Hindi, Korean, Mandarin, Punjabi, Russian, Spanish, and Vietnamese. 135 translation appointments/calls were required; attesting to the power of word of mouth, partner referral, bi-lingual Navigators, and effective outreach.
