

New question for applicants denied Medicaid and CHIP eligibility because of their immigration status

- **WHAT:** The Marketplace application now includes a new question to help consumers who have been denied Medicaid and CHIP eligibility by the state because of their immigration status.
- **WHO:** In situations where (1) the applicant attested to having eligible immigration status and (2) an applicant attested to having been denied eligibility for Medicaid or CHIP, a new question will appear asking the applicant whether they were denied Medicaid or CHIP based on their immigration status.
- **WHEN:** This new question appears on the application as of June 5, 2014

New question

- If the applicants received a denial for Medicaid or CHIP by the state because their immigration status makes them ineligible for either program, they should select “yes” for this question.
- When someone selects “yes” for this question, HealthCare.gov can more accurately determine the applicant’s eligibility for enrollment in a health plan through the Marketplace and eligibility for APTC and CSR when the applicant has an annual household income below 100% FPL.
