Measures Management & You Blueprint 13.0

We are pleased to announce the release of the latest version of the MMS Blueprint, version 13.0! The format of this version remains largely the same as version 12.0, with two notable exceptions.

First, the Blueprint has undergone a complete graphics overhaul. CMS assessed all of the tables and figures for usefulness and readability and then modified content as necessary. In some cases, this meant eliminating some graphics that were outdated or unnecessary and adding new graphics to promote a broader understanding of the Blueprint topics. Every graphic is now part of a set, making the aesthetic of the Blueprint more cohesive.

Second, CMS engaged an electronic clinical quality measures (eCQM) working group to help us and completely readdressed the content and presentation of the eCQM information within the Blueprint. This interaction resulted in the elimination of the section dedicated to eCQM (formerly Section 4) in favor of a more holistic and unified approach to addressing eCQMs by placing them alongside traditional

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measures throughout the document. There are now several eCQM-specific chapters, including:

Introduction to Electronic Clinical
Quality Measures
Electronic Clinical Quality Measure
(eCQM) Standards and Tools
Codes, Code Systems, and Datasets
(includes discussions of Values,
Value Sets, and the Value Set
Authority Center)

Two existing chapters underwent major revisions to incorporate more information on eCQMs:

Chapter 13	Measure Technical Specification
Chapter 21	Testing for Special Types of
	Measures.

Finally, CMS eliminated most of the eCQM-specific appendices in favor of incorporation of the information elsewhere in the document.

Other content changes in this version include a revised business case development section, as well as new language on the Technical Expert Panel structure and best practices.

The next Blueprint update, version 13.1, will launch in the fall of 2017.
