Per the VDC's requirement to remain current, the VDCs are planning to upgrade to CICS TS v5.2. Therefore, the Shared System Maintainers are required to migrate their shared systems applications software to CICS TS v5.2 in cooperation with the VDC's upgrade.

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services is requesting the FFS contractors and VDCs to upgrade their environments and software applications to CICS TS v5.2.

B. Policy: This CR does not involve any legislative or regulatory policies.
