SUBJECT: Enhancement for Undeliverable Pay Medicare Summary Notices (MSNs) for Multi-Carrier System (MCS) Users

**I. SUMMARY OF CHANGES:** This change request (CR) will develop an automated process in HIGLAS and MCS to withhold payment to beneficiaries when the beneficiary address is undeliverable, similar to the current provider process. This CR will also ensure the beneficiary payments are sent when the beneficiary address is updated to no longer be undeliverable.
