The contractor will perform analysis to determine the effort to upgrade MSSQL and Oracle Relational Data Base Management Systems to the newest available versions. These database management systems hold all the table data for the CCEM and have end of support cycles set by their vendors. MSSQL ends support for the 2008 version on 7/19/2019. The current Oracle version 18 database support ends 12/2020.
