Part of this process creates an internal claim number (ICN) using the Julian date of the back end processing. Because of the cutoff time frames for processing and the potential for large data files, it is possible for the date created by the CCEM for the ICN to not match the receipt date created by the translator based on those large volumes. To avoid any possible difference between the ICN and the receipt date, this Change Request (CR) will update the Encounter Data version of the CCEM to build the ICN from the receipt date.
