Background: The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services issued instructions under CR3929 dated July 15, 2005 that implemented the frequency of editing for smoking and tobacco-use cessation counseling services. CWF maintains the number of smoking cessation counseling sessions rendered to a beneficiary. This change request gives providers the capability of viewing the number of sessions a beneficiary has received via inquiry through CWF. Such capability will allow providers to be informed of a beneficiary's available coverage for this service.

The Common Working File (CWF) maintains the number of smoking and tobacco-use cessation counseling sessions rendered to a beneficiary. By entering the beneficiary's health insurance claim number (HICN), providers have the capability to view the number of sessions a beneficiary has received for this service via inquiry through CWF.
