**I. GENERAL INFORMATION**

**A. Background:**

Over the years, CMS has entered into agreements with several private sector entities to test the efficacy of private sector edits when applied to Medicare claims. To date, CMS has been unable to identify any tools that can proactively identify and prevent the payment of improper claims. However, technology has advanced since the last time CMS conducted such an evaluation.

The Automated Edit project will enable CMS to accurately assess the effectiveness of several entities in applying their analytic tools in a controlled claims bed environment and determine whether any of those entities and/or tools would result in added value to the Medicare FFS program.

**B. Policy:**

A single CWF host will support the Automated Edit Field Test by sending certain files to Automated Edit Support Contractors beginning July 5, 2011.
